Our tournament was held on February 22 with several members participating, which made the event a great success.

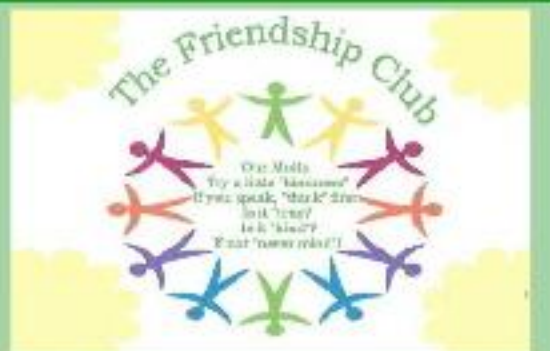
